Dear Applicant:

We determined you're exempt from federal income tax under Internal Revenue Code (IRC) Section 501(c)(13). This letter could help resolve questions on your exempt status.

Donors can deduct contributions they make to you if:

- Contributions are made to or for the use of a cemetery whose funds are irrevocably dedicated to the care of the cemetery and
- All the other requirements of section 170 are met.

Donors cannot deduct contributions or payments they make to you if:

- Contributions are for the perpetual care of a particular lot or crypt
- Payment is part of the purchase price of a burial lot or crypt, even though irrevocably dedicated to the perpetual care of the cemetery under IRC Section 170(c)(5).

If we indicated that you're required to file an annual information return, you must file one of the following:

- Form 990, Return of Organization Exempt From Income Tax
- Form 990-EZ, Short Form Return of Organization Exempt From Income Tax
- Form 990-N, Electronic Notice, e-Postcard for Tax-Exempt Organizations Not Required to File Form 990 or Form 990EZ.

If you don't file a required return or notice for three consecutive years, your exempt status will be automatically revoked.
